Pinckney Elementary School is one of two elementary schools located on Fort Jackson in Columbia, South Carolina. Our Namesake - Charles Cotesworth Pinckney

Our school is named after Charles Cotesworth Pinckney, who was an attorney and politician who served as an officer in the First South Carolina Regiment in defense of Charleston, S. C., the battle of Brandywine, the battle of Germantown and campaigns in the Floridas and Savannah in the American Revolution. He was a leader at the Constitutional Convention and a signer of the US Constitution.

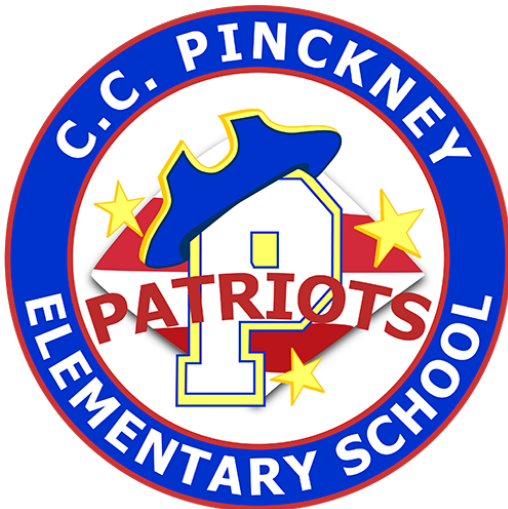
